

"Witnessing? A Dirty Word?"

"You shall be my witnesses." Jesus spoke these words to his apostles at the conclusion of his earthly ministry in Luke 24. He thus commissioned the fledgling Christian Church to bear witness to all that God had done through His life, death and resurrection.

But what do these words mean to us? Are we also witnesses to God's love for the world in Jesus? How are we to be witnesses to all the ends of the earth?

I believe we are too easily put off by the word "witnessing." We think of some religious crackpot standing on a corner screaming into a portable PA system, or people knocking on our doors warning us that "the end is near" and this is our last chance to "be saved."

Surely, this is not what Jesus means for you and me as believers! There is already too much craziness in this world, we don't need to add anymore.

I've been struck by the witnessing I've received as I've visited and called on some of our good "Trinity" folks. It did not come off as "hard sell" or "a put on." People were witnessing to me as they simply shared the stories of their lives, how their faith sustained them in rough times, and how they'd received God's generous blessings, and saving grace. Often they do not use "religious" or churchy language—they are simply sharing their story.

When we think of witnessing for Christ, I hope we will not think of the high pressure "put on" that so often put people off. Instead, when we think of how we may be Christ's witnesses to all the world, let's think of the ways we can simply share our own story of how God's love and blessing have come to us, and sustained us, not through our own merits, but for the sake of Jesus Christ our Lord.
